The Air Protection Branch of the Environmental Protection Division invites you to our next planned meeting on Tuesday, September 5 to further discuss Georgia's progress in implementing the federal Clean Air Mercury Rule (CAMR). The meeting will be held in the Tradeport Training Room from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

The Sept. 5 event will be a stakeholder meeting to discuss key issues that have been identified as a result of our last meeting on April 18 and to move forward with a more specific regulatory option. EPD will continue to use the written comments/suggestions submitted by stakeholders, as well as notes taken during these meetings, to prepare draft regulatory language.

EPD must submit a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision to EPA that includes source-specific allocations of mercury allowances, as well as regulations that address the extent of Georgia's involvement in the federal mercury cap-and-trade program.
