NOTICE OF PSD PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION, DRAFT TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT, AND  
PUBLIC HEARING

To All Interested Parties:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division announces its intent to issue a Title V Air Quality Operating Permit, with revised Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) emission limits, to the Johns Manville Corp. Winder Facility. The facility is located at 713 Bankhead Hwy, Winder, Georgia. The facility manufacturing operations involve processing of raw materials to manufacture fiberglass insulation and subsequent collection, forming, curing, trimming and packaging of fiberglass into residential or commercial products.

The primary purpose of this permit is to authorize Johns Manville Corp. to use an oxidation reduction agent in the raw materials for Melter 106. The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is preparing Title V Operating Permits in accordance with Title V of the Clean Air Act. This permit will be enforceable by the Georgia EPD, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and other persons as otherwise authorized by law.

The draft permit and all information used to develop the draft permit are available for review. This includes the application and all other relevant materials available to the permitting authority. This information is available for review at the office of the Air Protection Branch, 4244 International Parkway, Atlanta Tradeport - Suite 120, Atlanta, Georgia 30354. Copies of the draft permit, narrative, application summary, and permit application will be available at our internet web site <http://www.air.dnr.state.ga.us/sspp> by selecting "Draft Title V Permits" on the menu. The PSD Preliminary Review may be viewed at our internet web site <http://www.air.dnr.state.ga.us/sspp/psd/main.htm>. (Please note that the Internet is generally accessible from most public libraries in Georgia and at the Air Protection Branch office listed above.)

If copies are desired, a copying machine for public use is provided by EPD at the Atlanta Air Protection Branch office only and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. One copy of a single draft permit can be made free of charge. If additional copies are required, a copying charge of 25 cents per page will be assessed unless you bring your own copier. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday.

You are hereby notified of the opportunity for written public comments concerning the application for a permit amendment to construct/modify and operate the Line 106 fiberglass manufacturing line, the EPD's Preliminary Determination concerning the application, and the draft Part 70 permit modification. The Preliminary Determination is a summary of the technical review of the application and contains a copy of the Company's application along with supporting documents, and the draft permit modification. The draft permit serves as both a draft PSD permit and draft Part 70 permit amendment. Persons wishing to comment on the draft Title V Operating Permit and PSD limit revisions are required to submit their comments, in writing, to EPD at the above Atlanta Air Protection Branch address. Comments must be received by the EPD no later than 30 days after the date on which this notice is published in the newspaper. (Should the comment period end on a weekend or holiday, comments will be accepted up until the next working day.) The Division, in making its final decision to issue the Title V permit and PSD Final Determination, will consider all comments received on or prior to that date.

A public hearing related to this permit<sup>1</sup> will be held 7:00PM Monday, June 14, 2004 at the following location:

At that hearing, anyone may present data, make a statement or comment, or offer a viewpoint or argument either orally or in writing concerning the draft Title V permit with PSD limit revisions. During the Division's decision-making procedures to issue the Title V permit with PSD Final Determination, any information received during the public hearing will be considered together with information received during the comment period.

Following this 30 day public comment period, the draft permit will undergo a 45 day review by U.S. EPA in accordance with 40 CFR 70.8. Information pertaining to U.S. EPA's review period can be found on their website at [www.epa.gov/region4/air/permits](http://www.epa.gov/region4/air/permits).

After the EPA review has expired, the EPD will consider all comments, make any necessary changes, and issue the Title V Operating Permit. Copies of the final Title V Operating Permit, comments received, EPD's responses to comments, and any other relevant information will then be made available for public review during normal business hours at the office of the Air Protection Branch. A summary of comments and any changes made to the final permit will be found in an addendum to the narrative. A copy of this Title V Narrative, PSD Final Determination and the final Title V permit will be added to the information already available at the internet addresses given above.
