**Longleaf Energy Associates, LLC** submitted Application No. 18499 (received October 7, 2008) for a Case-by-Case MACT determination in order to operate a nominal 1,200 megawatt (MW) coal fired generation station. The Georgia Environmental Protection Division – Air Protection Branch has conducted a MACT review and has issued a Notice of MACT Approval. Draft Air Quality Permit Amendment No. 4911-099-0033-P-01-1 is attached with the Notice of MACT Approval which is included with this letter.

Enclosed is a copy of the public notice concerning the proposal. The public notice concerning the application and Notice of MACT Approval will appear in *Early County News* (legal organ for Early County) by LS Power Development, LLC no later than June 24, 2009. This notice is issued pursuant to State and Federal air quality regulations. Copies of the draft permit amendment, Notice of MACT Approval, and permit application will be available at our internet site <http://www.georgiaair.org/airpermit/> by selecting “Hot Topics” on the left side menu. (Please note that the Internet is generally accessible from most public libraries in Georgia and at the Air Protection Branch office listed above.)

Also enclosed is a copy of the Georgia EPD Notice of MACT Approval, a copy of draft Air Quality Permit No. 4911-099-0033-P-01-1, and Longleaf’s application for the permit. The Early County Courthouse has been designated as a location for public review of this information. We would appreciate you making these documents available at the Early County Courthouse for at least 60 days from the date of receipt of this letter. After this date, the documents can either be filed for your records or discarded.
