

Georgia Title V Permit Application

Minimum System Requirements

CPU: Pentium 75 MHz (Recommended PII 233 MHz)
Operating Systems: Windows™ 9x, Me, 2000 SP4, NT, XP
Disk space: approx.180 MB

Update all operating systems prior to installation.

Installation Instructions

1. Insert the Installation CD in your CD-ROM drive. The installation should start automatically. If it does not start automatically, click Start on the taskbar then choose Run. Type "D:\TVInstall.exe" then click OK to begin the installation, replacing "D" with the correct CD drive letter.

If you do not have Access 2000 on your computer the "runtime" version of Access 2000 will install first. Allow the runtime version to install and reboot if necessary. After rebooting the installation will restart. You must have administrator privileges on your computer to install this software in Windows 2000, NT and XP. The Runtime version of Access 2000 does NOT interfere with other versions of Access on your computer.

2. Follow the instructions on the screen to complete the installation, making sure to choose the correct installation type for your situation.
3. After installation and before using the application for the first time, you must "join the application workgroup." To join the workgroup, click "Start", go to "Programs", then "Georgia Title V Application", and then click on "Workgroup Administrator." When the workgroup administrator starts, click the Join button and navigate to the folder C:\Program Files\GATV then choose the file named GAPAWRKGRP.MDW (if you installed the application in a different location, navigate to the location where it was installed). Click "Open" then "OK" twice and exit the workgroup administrator. You should have received a message advising that you successfully joined the workgroup. NOTE: You only have to join the workgroup before your first use of the application.
4. To start the Georgia Title V Application, click "Start", then go to "Program", then "Georgia Title V Application", then click on "Georgia Title V Application" in the last pane that appears.
5. Note: if you uninstall the application, you will lose all data files. Use the export utility to backup your data file before uninstalling.

When applying updates downloaded from the web site, make sure to exit the application before applying the updates.
