NOTICE OF MACT APPROVAL

To All Interested Parties:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division announces a Notice of MACT Approval and its intent to issue Permit No. 3417-045-0059-E-01-0 to Decostar Industries, Inc. The facility will be located at 1 Decoma Drive, Carrollton, Georgia. The primary purpose of the permit is for the construction and operation of a plastic automotive parts manufacturing facility. This permit will be enforceable by the Georgia EPD and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The facility manufactures plastic automotive parts.

The Notice of MACT Approval, in the form of a draft Air Quality Permit, is available for review at Carroll County Commission, 423 College Street, Room 408, Carrollton, GA 300117.

The draft permit and all information used to develop the draft permit are available for your review. This includes the application, all relevant supporting materials and all other materials available to the permitting authority used in the permit review process. This information is available for your review at the office of the Air Protection Branch, 4244 International Parkway, Atlanta Tradeport - Suite 120, Atlanta, Georgia 30354. If you require copies of the draft permit, narrative, permit application, and application summary, these documents will be available at EPD's internet site.

If copies are desired, a copying machine for public use is provided by EPD at the Atlanta office only and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. A copying charge of 25 cents per page will be assessed. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday.

You are hereby notified of the opportunity to submit written public comments concerning the Notice of MACT Approval and the Air Quality Construction and Operating Permit. Persons wishing to comment on the draft Permit are required to submit their comments, in writing, to EPD at the above Atlanta address. Comments must be received by the EPD no later than 30 days after the date of publication in the newspaper. All comments received on or prior to that date will be considered by the Division in making its final decision to issue the permit.

Any requests for a public hearing must be made within the 30-day public comment period. A request for a hearing should be in writing and specify, in as much detail as possible, the portion of the Georgia Rules for Air Quality Control or the Federal Rules which the individual making the request is concerned may not have been adequately incorporated.

After the comment period has expired, the EPD will consider all comments, make any necessary changes, and issue the Permit. Copies of the final Permit, comments received, and any other relevant information will then be made available for public review during normal business hours at the Atlanta address.
