In accordance with the provisions of the Georgia Air Quality Act, O.C.G.A. Section 12-9-1, et seq and the Georgia Rules for Air Quality Control, Chapter 391-3-1, adopted pursuant to and in effect under the Act, the Permittee described above is issued an amendment to the Part 70 Operating Permit for:

Revision to testing condition 4.2.1 to allow testing up to 180 days from start up for the fourth furnace and correct typographical error in Conditions 4.2.3 and 4.2.5

This Permit Amendment is conditioned upon compliance with all provisions of The Georgia Air Quality Act, O.C.G.A. Section 12-9-1, et seq, the Rules, Chapter 391-3-1, adopted and in effect under that Act, or any other condition of this Permit Amendment and Permit No. 3321-301-0012-V-03-0. Unless modified or revoked, this Permit Amendment expires simultaneously with Part 70 Permit No. 3321-301-0012-V-03-0.

This Permit Amendment may be subject to revocation, suspension, modification or amendment by the Director for cause including evidence of noncompliance with any of the above; or for any misrepresentation made in Application No. TV-17733 dated October 15, 2007; any other applications upon which this Permit Amendment or Permit No. 3321-301-0012-V-03-0 are based; supporting data entered therein or attached thereto; or any subsequent submittal or supporting data; or for any alterations affecting the emissions from this source.

This Permit Amendment is further subject to and conditioned upon the terms, conditions, limitations, standards, or schedules contained in or specified on the attached 1 page.

4.2 Specific Testing Requirements

- 4.2.1 Within 180 days of the restart date, the Permittee shall conduct a performance tests on Stack Source Codes 910, 920, and 930 for particulate matter and/or metal HAPS to demonstrate initial compliance with the emission limitations established in Condition 3.3.1 and 3.3.2. For Stack Source Code 940 the permittee shall conduct a performance test for particulate matter and /or metal HAPS to demonstrate initial compliance with the emission limitations established in Condition 3.3.1 and 3.3.2 within 180 days from the start up of the Fourth Furnace.

- 4.2.3 Within 180 days of the restart date, the Permittee shall conduct a performance test for Volatile Organic compounds (VOC) on Stack Source Code 920, 921 and 940.

- 4.2.5 Within 180 days of the restart date, the Permittee shall perform a Method 9 test to demonstrate compliance with the opacity limit in Condition 3.3.5. Subsequent performance tests to demonstrate compliance with the opacity limit in Condition 3.3.5 must be conducted no less frequently than once every 6 months from the last test.
